

# Piland-Pilant-Pilot-Pyland-Pylant-Pylate Autosomal DNA Project

If you've tested with AncestryDNA, you're invited to join the **Piland-Pilant-Pilot-Pyland-Pylant-Pylate Autosomal DNA Project**. As the founder of this project and its Facebook group page, I've identified **1,200** testers (as of 28 January 2023) who are descendants of the immigrant ancestor, James Pylant (1604—1660) of Isle of Wight County, Virginia. By analyzing a DNA match list, I can determine kinships between other participants. This has helped to identify previously unknown branches of the Piland-Pilant-Pilot-Pylant-Pylant-Pylate family tree. (Note: This does **not** give me or anyone else access to your DNA file. AncestryDNA only allows you or the manager of your account to download your DNA file.)

To participate in the Piland-Piland-Pilot-Pyland-Pylate-Pylate Autosomal DNA Project, follow the steps below:

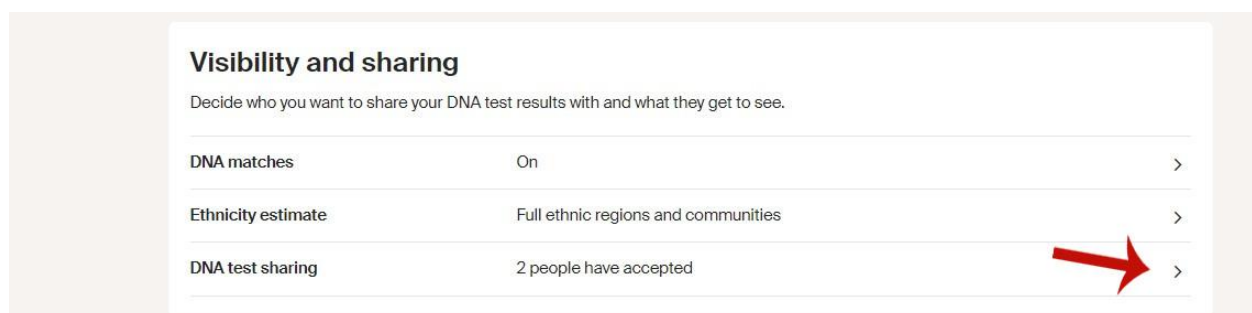
## STEP 1:

Go to your AncestryDNA page and click "Settings" in the far upper right corner...



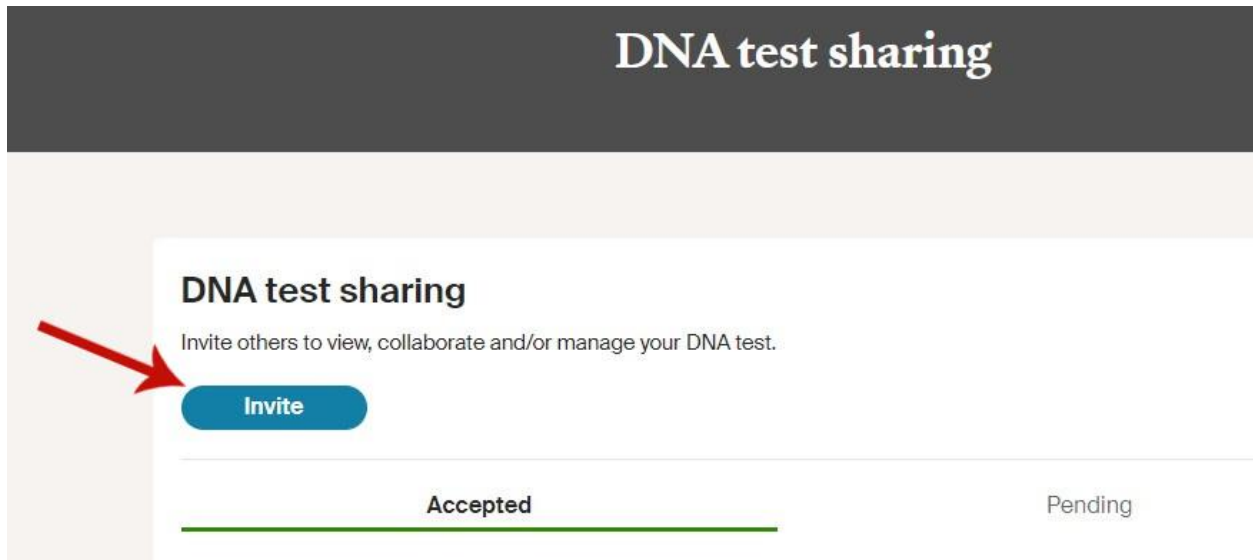
## STEP 2:

Scroll down to "Visibility and sharing" and click the gray arrow on the right side of "DNA test sharing" ...



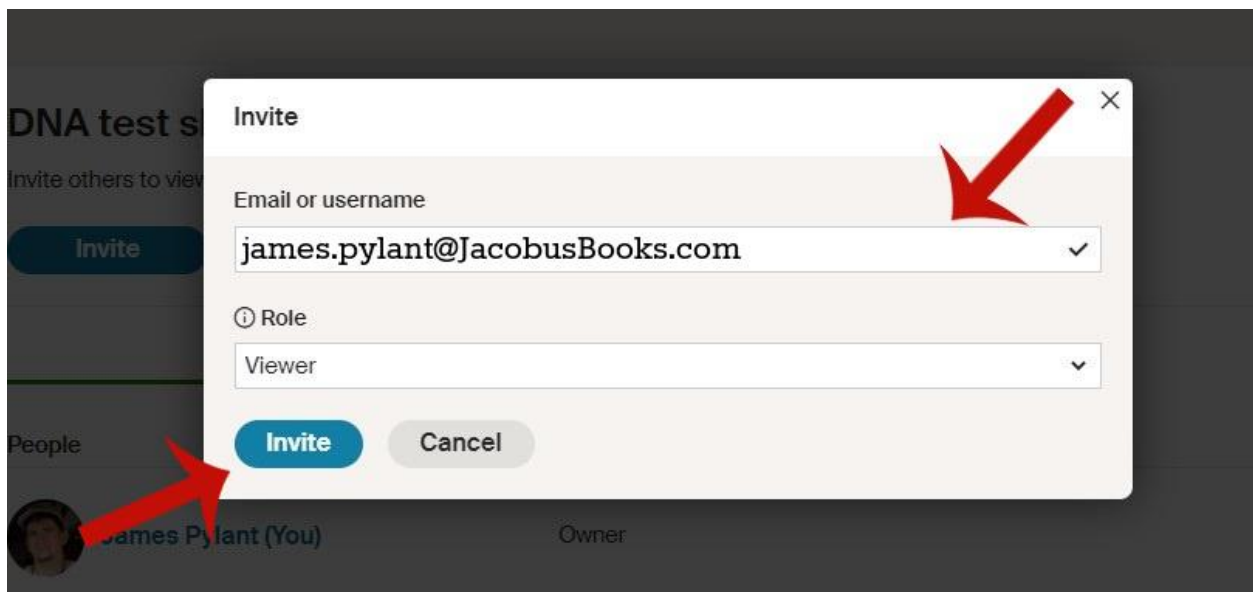
**STEP 3:**

(These notes will not be visible to others.) Click "Invite."
